

QUILT DEFINITIONS

Bed Quilt - A Quilt intended for use on a bed.

Applique Quilt - Applique predominates over the techniques used.

Pieced Quilt - Piecing predominates over other techniques used.

Mixed Technique Quilt - Includes two or more reasonably balanced construction techniques.

Wall Quilt - A quilt intended for display on a wall, decorative rather than functional.

Fabric Art - Includes ORIGINAL work (not a copy) created as work visual art reflecting innovative construction and design techniques, subject matter, or materials.

Miniature Quilt - Small scale quilts are proportionately accurate renderings of larger quilts, and may include portraits, landscapes, whole cloth, or use various techniques. Perimeter is 96 inches or less, no block size larger than 4 inches.

Ensemble Quilt - Quilt made by two or more individuals. The category includes all techniques, as well as quilting performed by someone other than the maker.

Crafts - Quilted items such as table runners, place mats, tote bags, purses, pillows, etc.

Wearable Art - All quilted wearable garments completed by the person entering the item.

Antique Quilt - Quilt made before 1950
